NTM declared a dispute with Transnet Rail Engineering in regards to Recognition.

The Conciliation was held this morning at the Transnet Bargaining Council.

As UTATU SARWHU and SATAWU we requested to be joined in dispute as we have an interest in terms of the Labour Relations Act.

The dispute was thus withdrawn by NTM as the Transnet Bargaining Council lacked jurisdiction to deal with the dispute in terms of Section 21 of the Labour Relations Act.

They have however indicated that they will now refer the dispute to the CCMA.

We request our members to please be vigilant and not be misled by any person from NTM that approaches you to sign as a member. They have no recognition within Transnet and are misleading members.

We also request all Trade Union Representatives to please be vigilant and report to us if you find them on the premises of Transnet as they have no rights to be on the property recruiting members.

Your co-operation in this time will be highly appreciated.
